**Welcome back Sabres – to the 2026–2027 School Year.
Here is some information for you.**

- **Meet the Teacher Night** – On Thursday, September 3, NSES and NSCHS will be doing a joint Meet the Teacher Night. There will be opportunities to connect with your student's teachers, tables from Community Organizations as well as hot dogs provided for the school communities.
- **Student Enrollment Verification** – An email will be sent out for you to complete this form to make sure each student's information is the most up to date as possible.
- **NSES Milk Program** – The milk program will start on September 8 this year. The cost for cards will be \$15.00 for a 10 count card and \$30 for a 20 count card. Milk cards will be available for purchase on your PowerSchool account starting September 1st. You may also send money to the office if you prefer. We don't often have change in the school so any additional funds will be left on your PowerSchool account to be used at a later time.
- **NSES Nutrition Program** – This program provides fruit & vegetables daily should children need a little extra snack. Also sandwiches in case students forget their lunch. The Muffin program will continue this year and information on any recipes used will be shared. Throughout the year, NSES does other special days for the students, such as pancakes and smoothies. If your child/children have any food allergies/restrictions, please let the school know at nse@blackgold.ca AND on your Student Enrollment Verification.
- **Lost & Found:** Located by the school office, please check here anytime your child is missing items. If you put your child's name in their items, it will make it easier to get them back to them.
- **New Sarepta Elementary Website** – nse.blackgold.ca – Check it out for information including our School Events Calendar and much more!
- **Reporting Absences** – NSES uses a student absence reporting system called **SafeArrival**. This system makes it easy for you to report your child's absence. Check our website for more information – nse.blackgold.ca. You can report your child's absence in advance using any of these 3 convenient methods:
 1. On your mobile device – download & install the SM Home app
 2. Use the SchoolMessenger website. >>Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
 3. Call the toll-free number 780-955-4526 to report an absence using the automated phone system.
- **LRC Fitness Pass:** The LRC gives NSES a free Annual LRC Family pass, which allows 2 adults & all children under 18 years of age, residing in the same household to experience the centre. *Contact the office to request to check it out for one week at a time.* Families bring the pass to either of the Guest Services desks at the LRC & can be used for multiple members of the family at each visit.
- **Clothing Requested:** Remember to have a spare set of clothes for your children in case of weather/craft accidents. If you have any pants that you might want to donate, consider sending them to us as we like to have extras on hand (sizes 5-10 are especially appreciated).
